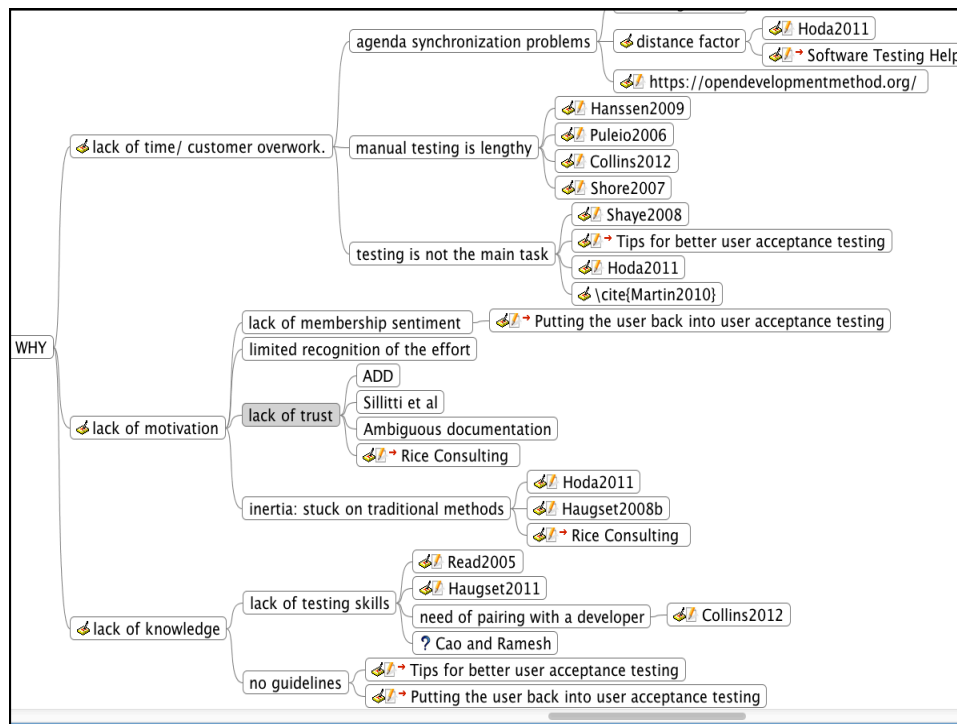
Agile methodologies: “customer collaboration over contract negotiation”

- AT is a truly collaborative endeavour between developers and customers

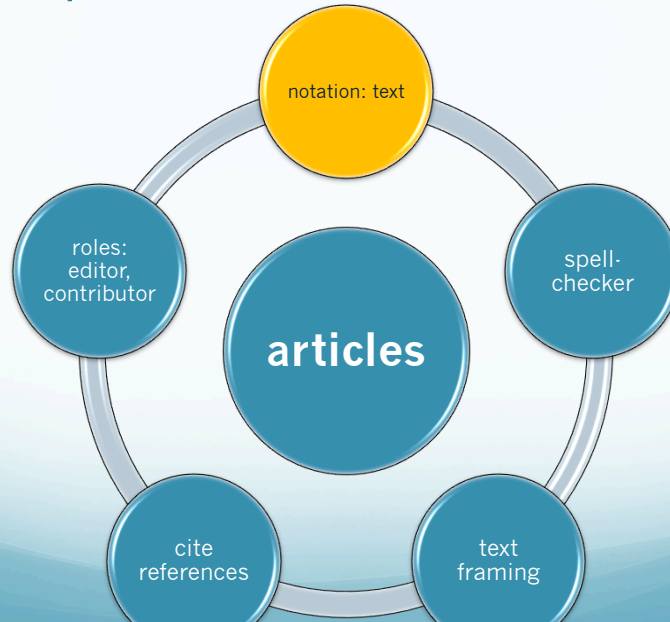
But collaborative testing is not necessarily “pair testing”
